70% OF LGBTQ YOUTH IN CARE REPORTED PHYSICAL VIOLENCE DUE TO THEIR SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GENDER IDENTITY



100% OF LGBTQ YOUTH IN NEW YORK CITY GROUP HOMES REPORTED VERBAL HARASSMENT



78% OF LGBTQ YOUTH WERE REMOVED OR RAN AWAY FROM THEIR FOSTER HOMES BECAUSE OF HOSTILITY TOWARDS THEIR SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GENDER IDENTITY



56% OF LGBTQ YOUTH HAVE SPENT TIME LIVING ON THE STREETS BECAUSE THEY FELT SAFER THERE THAN THEY DID LIVING IN THEIR FOSTER OR GROUP HOME
