* The semester in which a course load of less than 9 credit hours will reach an accumulated total equal to the minimum number of hours required by their program. They should then register for that number of credits, but not less than 3. From that point on, they will continue to be considered full time until they complete their thesis or dissertation, as long as they enroll for at least 3 credit hours.

* Professional Preparation credits: For students with teaching experience, take an elective with focus on pedagogy (e.g., ENG 626). For students with no or minimal teaching preparation
COM --> for students with no or minimal teaching experience, require them to take COM585 during their first semester.
ENG --> 1. Take ENG 511 in their first semester if they don't have that class in their transcripts. If they are teaching ENG101, biweekly meetings with Casie
2. Teach ENG101 and have the biweekly meetings with Casie (not for credit) and take preparation form 333x as CRD885
3. If they don't have teaching experience, take CRD885 (shadowing a course) as preparation for ENG 101 — and not teach.
